



## Humanitarian Simulation Exercise (SimEx-2019) Participant Invitation

This training, unique in North America, is for students as well as professionals who want to develop their competencies in humanitarian response.

### This program runs for 5 days:

- 2 days in class - May 8th and 9th, 2019, Université Laval Campus, Québec City.

This training will allow you to familiarize yourself with the context of humanitarian aid and important issues such as ethical issues, stress management, safety management and leadership.

- 3 days on the field - May 10-12, 2019, Training facility, region of Quebec City.

This simulation will take place on a realistic outdoor location in the Quebec City region, set in a fictional country that is struggling with a humanitarian crisis that you and your team will have to respond to. This simulation is organized and staged by more than 50 trainers, the majority of whom are experienced humanitarian workers. They will also share with you their experiences and passion for humanitarian aid.

### The training includes:

- teaching materials;
- accommodation for 2 nights (May 10-11)
- transportation to and from the simulation site from Université Laval Campus;
- the food for all 3 days of simulation;
- and above all, a unique and fascinating...and REAL experience !



**Important note:** This training will be delivered in both French and English.

Anglophone are welcome and welcome to speak in the language of their choice. But as most of the content will be presented in French, it is strongly advised to be able to understand some French.
